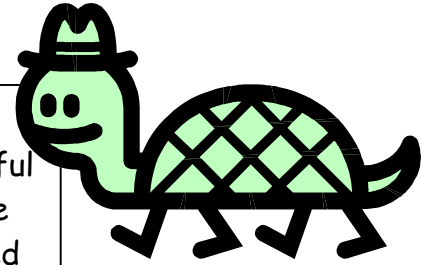




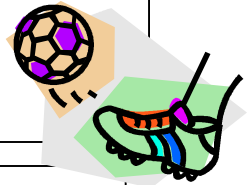
# February 2005 Newsletter
