Topics for this month

Literacy -We will be studying literacy through non-fiction book this month. The children will learn to research and where to find non-fiction facts, use the library and the Dewey systems.

Numeracy -The children will continue to concentrate on number bonds to both 10 and 20. Emphasis will be placed on mental maths. During the month we will work on measurements and capacity.



Science - We will be looking at the habitats of different animals and fish. We will make a variety of booklets, which will show the life cycle of animals.
